


MODIFYING THE TEMPLATES

To modify the social media and Eventbrite page banner templates, you will need to have PowerPoint installed on your computer. You must also download and install the <u>Open Sans fonts</u> located in the template folder.

Each template includes placeholders for your organization's logo, the event time and location, the link to your event registration page, and event partner logos.

Once you are finished modifying a template, export the file as an image by choosing File > Export > Change File Type > PNG Portable Network Graphics.



To modify the e-bulletin templates, you must click <u>this link</u> to import it into an existing Mailchimp account (free for up to 2,000 contacts) and choose Edit > Create Campaign.
